2018-19 SEASON-Regulation Bulletin No. 2

Beginning **May 15, 2019** through June 14, 2019 the minimum interstate grade for Valencia & Late Type Oranges is U S # 1 Golden

- Ambersweet orange maturity standards are in Department of Citrus Rule Chapter 20.13
- Fresh grapefruit maturity standards are outlined in the Packing House Maturity Chart

The grade and size regulations shown below are separated into Interstate and Export. Interstate shipments include the continental United States (except Florida East and South of the Suwannee River). Puerto Rico, Canada and Mexico are export markets.
